Curriculum Overview

MATHS Fractions, multiplication and Division

Sustainability



This term the children will be looking at fractions, multiplication and division. They will practise both the formal written method for multiplication and division but also a variety of efficient mental strategies. It is important that children explore different methods and apply their knowledge of multiplication and division to solve practical problems using a concrete, pictorial, abstract approach.

This half term the children will be studying Sustainability, with a focus on recycling and how human choices affect the environment we live in. They recognise how people try to manage environments sustainably. They explain their own views and begin to suggest relevant geographical questions and issues.



ENGLISH

Families and People Who This half term in English we will be studying 'The Garbage King'. The Garbage

King is a 2003 children's fiction book written by Elizabeth Laird and illustrated by Yosef Kebede. Laird was inspired to write the book after living and working in Ethiopia, where, in Addis Ababa, she saw children who lived on the streets who had inspiring abilities to cope with difficult living conditions. The children will develop their oracy skills through Talk for Writing lessons, along with grammar input. They will use the skills they have learned to write diary entries, letters, a narrative and non-chronological report based on the book. They will write setting and character descriptions

This term in RSE, children will be exploring the family structure and identifying the different roles of the people who

look after them.

SCIENCE

Earth and Space

The children will describe the movement of Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in our Solar System. They will describe the movement of the Moon relative to Earth and describe the Sun, Earth and the Moon as approximately spherical bodies. They will use the idea of Earth's rotation to explain



day and night and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky.
